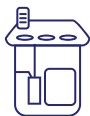


# 10 Point Annual Tune-Up

Test and regulate burner controls



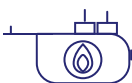
Replace fuel oil filter



Clean and regulate fuel pumps



Replace nozzle



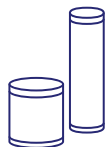
Clean and test ignition system



Clean and vacuum boiler or furnace as required



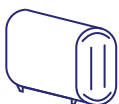
Lubricate and oil all motor bearings



Seal all boiler gaps around boiler doors and flue



Regulate oil burner for maximum efficiency



Check fuel tank and lines for leaks

# Standard Service Plan

Includes **10 Point Annual Tune-Up**, after hour's services for emergency no heat calls plus the following repair or replacement of parts listed below.

- Aquastat  
*(\$150 credit towards replacement Hydrolevel, Honeywell)*
- Fan or blower belts
- Oil burner motor (3450 rpm)
- Fuel pump (3450 rpm)
- Fuel pump coupling
- Fan & limit control (*warm air system*)
- Jet line
- Burner switch
- Cad cell relay
- Cad cell eye and harness
- Pressure control (*Steam System*)
- Glass Gauge and washers (*Steam System*)
- Switching relay
- Heat only Thermostat (*non-programmable*)
- Igniter
- Transformer
- Solenoid oil valve

## Standard Service Plan General Terms and Conditions

Issuance of a Standard Service Plan is subject to inspection and approval by Stadium Oil Heat (SOH). If the system does not qualify for our Service Plan, you will be charged for any work and parts provided. SOH reserves the right to cancel and/or non-renew a service plan at our sole discretion. Only parts specifically listed in the agreement are covered. These plans do not cover parts or labor for ancillary components such as ducts, piping, radiators, zone valves, fuel tanks, vent alarm parts associated with water or steam (including flushing of steam boilers) smoke pipe or the chimney. It does not cover service calls due to run-out of fuel when not the fault of the company or when alternate heat or heat sources are in use, due to abuse, furnace switches turned off, blown fuses, tripped circuit breakers, flooding, inadequate ventilation of the system, vacant and unattended premises. Additional charges may apply due to delay or extra expense due to the inaccessibility of the system. All non-covered parts and services will be billed at our prevailing rate. This agreement is not a guarantee that the equipment will not fail to operate. It is an agreement to maintain and repair the equipment as provided for in the agreement. We are not responsible for any damages due to any type of malfunction, leaks, environmental impairment, including consequential damages, unavoidable delays beyond our control, work required as a result of abnormal conditions, such as floods, hurricanes, blackouts, freeze-ups, broken pipes, acts of God, the government or other parties. No warranty is made as to the ability of the system to supply heat or hot water required by customer. OUR LIABILITY UNDER THIS AGREEMENT IS LIMITED TO THE REASONABLE VALUE OF THE SERVICE AND PARTS OFFERED IN THIS AGREEMENT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,000.00. Service plans may be cancelled at Stadium's sole discretion upon termination of automatic delivery, if maintenance/repairs are done on system but others not approved by SOH. If service plan was provided free and client fails to meet terms of free plan, client will be charged and responsible for all labor, service and parts provided to date. There will be no pro-rated refunds for early termination of the agreement.

This plan covers residential burners up to 3 GPH firing rate. General Electric, and rotary and low speed (1725 RPM) burners are excluded.
